REOPENING GUIDELINES

EFFECTIVE JUNE 7, 2020

Why follow these guidelines?

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

- Sligo Baptist urges all who attend, or are considering attending, to be safe. Wait until you feel comfortable to join in worship on-site.
- Sligo Baptist will continue to offer on-line (at-home) worship video for the foreseeable future.
- All surfaces in the bathrooms, the chairs, surfaces, and fixtures in the Fellowship Hall will be disinfected with an approved disinfectant each week before worship is held.
- Worship will take place in the Fellowship Hall with chairs grouped in units and spaced 6 feet apart.
- Please consider others as you interact with your church family. Maintain proper social distancing (6 feet) when moving about the church campus and in the building. As hard as it will be, please refrain from handshaking and hugging while on the church campus. It is recommended that anyone who arrives at the church wear an approved mask from their car to their seat. Please keep your mask on while you are moving about.
- Those gathered for worship will be released by rows at the end of the service and should wear their mask while exiting.
- If you have a temperature, or do not feel well, please stay safe and stay home.
- On good weather days, the entry doors will be propped open so no transfer of germs may occur from contact with door knobs. When needed, Door Greeters will handle the doors, and will be the only contact with the fixtures on the doors.
- Restrooms will be cleaned regularly. Bathroom monitors will disinfect the bathrooms with a CDC approved disinfectant.
- The offering plate will not be passed during worship. Offering boxes have been mounted on the walls near the exits. Please drop your offering in the boxes before or after service.
- Eighty percent alcohol hand sanitizer will be available at each entrance and near the bathrooms. You may choose to bring your own hand sanitizer as well.
- The church kitchen will be closed.
- If you are in the High-Risk group; please consider taking more time to return. Our services will be available on video.
